Day 1

Sunday 27th May

Weather: Heathrow: Dull. France: Rain at first, brightening later.

We arrived at Heathrow Terminal 4 for the 08-40hrs British Airways flight BA360 to Lyon St Exupery, arriving at 11-10hrs local time. We soon cleared passport control and baggage reclaim and made our way out to the arrivals where we met up with Paul and Alan, who showed us to the car park, where we boarded our minibuses for the journey down to the Vercors region.

Our route took us down the A43 and A48 motorways towards Grenoble, before turning up onto the Vercors plateaux. Continuing on through Lans en Vercors, we had intended to travel through the stunning Gorges de la Bourne. However, it had been closed for scheduled road works, so we made a detour, where Paul stopped to show us the last remnants of *Orchis pallens* (Pale-flowered Orchid), before arriving at the Hotel Bellier in the quiet town of La Chapelle en Vercors, our base for the next seven nights. Here, we met up with Philip, our final group member.

At 17-00hrs several group members took a walk around the village, seeing a distant pair of Short-toed Eagles and a family of three Black Redstarts. The whole group assembled at 18-30hrs and Paul and Alan outlined the proposed itinerary for the week. Dinner was served at 19-30hrs in the hotel restaurant.

Day 2

Monday 28th May

Weather: Cloudy at first, snow by mid morning, showers in the afternoon and rain later.

Only a short journey was planned for today and we left the hotel and travelled towards Vassieux en Vercors. We made a short stop at the cemetery where the victims of the Nazi massacre at Vassieux, during the Second World War, are buried, before driving up towards the Col de Chau. While we were there, a splendid Red-backed Shrike, Skylark singing overhead, and Yellowhammer were seen, and Common Quail were calling in the adjacent fields. In the small quarry behind the cemetery, a small colony of *Orchis militaris* (Military Orchid) was seen.

A short stop was made, on the way up to the Col de Chau to look down into the valley and across towards the Haut Plateaux, although, our distant views were hampered by cloud. *Saponaria ocymoides* (Rock Soapwort), *Erinus alpinus* (Fairy Foxglove) and *Rhamnus alpinus* (Alpine Buckthorn) were all seen.

From here we made our way over the Col de Chau and on to Font d'Urle, an area of open limestone crags and meadows, used for ski-ing in winter. However, it was looking very wintry as we approached, as the snow/sleet was falling gently. We began our walk by slowly walking up to towards the viewpoint. This produced the remnants of *Ranunculus pyrenaicus* [*R. kuepferi*] (Pyrenean Buttercup), *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elder-flowered Orchid), and the fruiting spikes of *Erythronium dens-canis* (Dog-tooth Violet).

Several Yellow-billed Choughs circled above us and Northern Wheatear and Water Pipit were also present. The birders also found Ring Ouzal around the small collection of dwellings.

At the viewpoint, we also found *Androsace villosa* (Rock Jasmine), *Gentiana clusii* (Clusius's Gentian) and *Dryas octopetala* (Mountain Avens). We also found several spikes of *Coeloglossum viride* (Frog Orchid) poking through the snow, before returning to the vehicles for lunch.

We left the Font d'Urle to find a more sheltered spot for our picnic. We found a spot by the river in the Commune de Bouvante. Here we saw *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), and *Ranunculus aconitifolium* (Aconite-leaved Buttercup). There was very little bird activity, save a Robin singing in the forest.

After our picnic, we made our way to the Col de Machine and on down through the spectacular Route de Combe Laval, stopping at the viewpoint on the west side, overlooking the Isere Valley and the town of St Jean en Royan, before retracing our steps to a lay-by near some steep cliffs. Alan attempted to call Wallcreeper, without success, but House Martins and a splendid Black Kite, which dived down the gorge in spectacular fashion, were seen.

The botanists found *Pinguicula gyroflexa* (Tufted lousewort), *Lamium garganicum* (Large Red Deadnettle) and *Valeriana tripteris* (Three-leaved Valerian). A brief stop for some very welcome coffee was made at the Auberge at the Col da la Machine, before returning back to La Chapelle.

Day 3

Tuesday 29th May

Weather: Misty and wet at first, brightening later with some sun and a fresh wind.

Today we travelled down towards the Col de Machine, and on over the Col de la Bataille. We were unable to appreciate the stunning views, due to the thick mist, however the birding van was entertained by counting Mistle Thrushes in the mist and got to 24.

Continuing on over the Col, we dropped down towards the town of Leoncal, where we turned left and headed south to the Col de Bacchus. Here we stopped to explore some lane verges and a broad road verge finding *Gymnadenia conopsea* (Fragrant Orchid), *Orchis ustulata* (Burnt-tipped Orchid), *Orchis tridentata* (Toothed Orchid) and *Globularia punctata* (Common Globularia) among many others. Red-backed Shrike, Yellowhammer and Black Kite were also seen.

From here we carried on south through Pain de Baix, where we saw a large colony of Alpine Chough moving against the steep rock face. As we continued south to wards Beaufort sur Gervanne, we spotted Stonechat, Red-backed Shrike and Short-toed Eagle. At Beaufort, we turned west to an area of open scrubby land with marginal woodland for our lunch stop.

Before lunch, we took a walk out into some scrubby pasture. Here we recorded *Ophrys drumana*, *Helianthemum apenninum* (White Rockrose), *Ophrys scolopax*, *Ophrys apifera* (Bee Orchid). Cirl Bunting and Whitethroat were seen but the birding highlight was two Alpine Swifts hunting low at an incredible speed over the scrub.

After lunch, we explored the woodland adding *Limodorum abortivum* (Violet Bird's-nest Orchid), emerging *Himantoglossum hircinum* (Lizard Orchid), *Helianthemum canum* (Hoary Rockrose), *Cephalanthera rubra* (Red Helleborine) and *Quercus pubescens* (Downey Oak), to the plant list.

At this point we retraced our steps a little back toward Beaufort, where we explored some arable margins. Six Rock Sparrows, another Short-toed Eagle and Tawny Pipit were seen. For the botanists there was *Melampyrum arvense* (Field Cow-wheat), *Ranunculus arvensis* (Corn Buttercup), *Orobanche ramosa* (Branched Broomrape) and *Trifolium incarnatum* (Crimson Clover). It was now time to head north. However, we did stop at Leocel for refreshments on this very chilly day.

Retracing our steps back over the Col de la Machine we made a short stop so that the group could have an opportunity to further enjoy the spectacular scenery.

Day 4

Wednesday 30th May

Weather: Fresh at first, becoming Fine, warm and sunny.

Today we made our way up to the northern end of the Vercors Plateaux. Our main objective for the day was to try and find a Wallcreeper. Leaving La Chapelle, we drove north to the village of St. Martin en Vercors. Here, we turned right up towards Herbouilly as the Gorges de la Bourne was closed for maintenance. We continued on the back road to Villard de Lans. We made a stop at a viewpoint that overlooked the ruined village of Valchevriere, another poignant reminder of the suffering of the French resistance in the Second World War.

We travelled on to Lans en Vercors, and up to Les Merciers, where we parked in a wide quarry-like lay by. When we had topped up with water, the birders set off with Alan for a tall crag where Alan and Paul knew of an old site where Wallcreeper had been seen in past years. Before getting to the crag top the group enjoyed good views of a pair of Rock Buntings. Then, settling down on the top of a viewing point to wait and watch for signs of movement, we made ourselves comfortable.

The views were stunning towards the Alps covered in snow with the sun glinting on the mountains. Whilst it was good to see more Alpine Swifts, Kestrel and Peregrine close to the views of a Wallcreeper was short and quick and only seen by a couple. Meanwhile, Paul took the botanists off to explore. They found *Rhamnus alpina* (Alpine Buckthorn), *Saxifraga paniculata* (Live-long Saxifrage), *Ranunculus aconitifolius* (Aconite-leaved Buttercup) and *Saxifraga rotundifolia* (Round-leaved Saxifrage).

After a splendid morning, Paul and Alan decided that we would move to another location for our picnic. They chose a lovely spot set back from the road, next to a stream near Engins. Grey Wagtail and Dipper were spotted in the stream as we were departing. From here we moved to the Hamlet of Traffe where we explored some mixed woodland. *Corallorhiza trifida* (Coralroot Orchid), *Convallaria majus* (Lily of the Valley), *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine) and *Pyrola minor* (Common Wintergreen) were all seen. The highlight for the birders was the finding of a Black Woodpecker nest with a juvenile female showing well, and calling from the nesthole. An adult was seen flying nearby.

Leaving Traffe a quick stop was made at the supermarket then back towards La Chapelle. The Gorges de la Bourne had re-opened that afternoon so we traveled through it, making a stop to enjoy the views and watch a Dipper in the stream, sunning itself on a rock.

Day 5

Thursday 31st May

Weather: Fine, hot sunny at first; rain, hail, thunder and lightning later.

A very early start for the birders today. After breakfast at 4am, Alan drove a group up to the Reserve Naturelle des Hauts Plateaux du Vercors, parking at a high La Coche car park. We began the walk up to the Plateaux, making our way along rough tracks for about a kilometre with the dawn chorus in full flow.

Once on the high plateau dawn was breaking and the group enjoyed good views of a party of Crossbill at the top of one nearby pine tree, then a Ring Ouzel singing from the top of another. Walking through the wide glade the bubbling sound of Black Grouse could be heard and after some careful searching the group enjoyed the spectacle of a male displaying on a treetop. Other Black Grouse could be heard and the bubbling display call was audible for over three hours.

A wide sweep around the plateau revealed splendid views of many of the upland birds including Citril Finch, Crested Tit and several Tree Pipits singing from treetops. An exciting moment was enjoyed when a Golden Eagle glided overhead. All too soon it was time to gently descend from the plateaux and with a little time to spare before meeting the botanists for lunch, the group went to a viewpoint overlooking the plateaux where a Griffon Vulture circled overhead.

Meanwhile, the botanists had a more leisurely start, leaving La Chapelle at 09-00hrs, making their first stop on the back lane near the hamlet of Tourtre. Here on the verge we found *Asarum europeum* (Asarabacca), *Ophrys fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid) and *Astragalus glycyphyllos* (Wild Liquorice).

From here we moved south to a point outside St. Agnan en Vercors. Here they explored the verges and adjacent meadows. In a wet flush they found *Dactylorhiza majalis* subsp. *alpestris* (a Broad-leaved Marsh Orchid) and *Coeloglossum viride* (Frog Orchid). Moving on we made our way up onto the Hauts Plateaux, stopping briefly at a view point, where Paul pointed out the differences between *Cardamine heptophylla* (Seven-leaflet Bittercress) and *Cardamine pentaphylla*.

After parking at the La Coche car park, we made our way along the roads and tracks that the birders had taken some hours before. Large numbers of *Orchis mascula* subsp. *acutifolius* (an Early Purple Orchid) were seen, as well

as *Daphne cnorum* (Garland Flower), *Tulipa sylvestris* subsp. *australis* (Wild Tulip) and *Pulsatilla alpestre* (Alpine Pasque Flower). Before long we encountered the birding group on their way back down to the car park.

Continuing on, we began exploring the mainly coniferous woodland, with *Abies alba* (Silver Fir) and *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce) predominating. We soon emerged from the rocky forest onto the plateau, finding *Pinus uncinata* (Mountain Pine), *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (Bearberry) and *Vaccinium uliginosum* (Bog Whortleberry). After spending some time watching Common Crossbill and Citril Finch, we made our way down to join the birders for lunch. Just as we completed our picnic, the rain arrived. At this point, both groups took the route along the east side of the Plateaux, returning to the hotel for a rest.

In the evening, we were joined, for dinner, by local guide, Bruno Veillet, who was to accompany us on the journey back to the Hauts Plateaux to look for owls. Unfortunately, the rain was extremely heavy and unrelenting, so it was decided by Paul and Alan, to abandon the excursion.

Day 6

Friday 1st June

Weather: Fresh and bright early on, becoming fine, hot and sunny.

It was time for a change of direction today, and we began by driving south from La Chapelle en Vercors. Our first stop was at the head of the spectacular Col de Rousset. From here the views are truly magnificent. However, although there was little moving, we did hear Dunnock and Tree Pipit. We did not spend too long admiring the view, and soon made our way on south.

Moving on down the valley, we made a second stop near Chanaloc to watch Griffon Vultures sitting on the crag and leaving their roosts. Several of these splendid birds did not disappoint, and everyone had good views of them in flight. In addition, Alan and Marjorie spotted a single Egyptian Vulture fly in to land in a tree and begin preening. Alan managed to get both species in the telescope, so all the party were able to see them. On the verge there were three or four large plants of *Ononis speciosus* (Shrubby Restharrow) and a few stems of *Limadorum abortivum* (Violet Bird's-nest Orchid).

At the bottom of the valley we turned east through the town of Die. As we were leaving Die raptors were seen so we stopped to check them out to find a spiral of thermaling Griffon Vultures. Also there was a splendid Short-toes Eagle which came in and landed nearby allowing all group members to get superb scope views.

We then drove on through Pont de Quart and Chatillon en Diois to the tiny village of Menee and on up through Les Nonniaires towards the Col de Menee to see *Cypripedium calceolus* (Lady's Slipper Orchid) on a wooded verge. The plants were in almost perfect condition, given the weather of the last two days, and everyone remarked at the spectacle.

From here we continued by towards the Col, as we had information from our local guide that there were Ortolan Buntings in this area. In heavy rain Alan and Philip searched out these birds and managed to flush a single bird, which fleetingly flew across the road and disappeared. Northern Wheatear and Yellowhammer were also seen. We turned around and headed south to the Vallee de Combeau.

As we drove up to our lunch spot, Philip spotted a pair of Chamoix on an adjacent slope, and at eye level. These proved extremely good value, and remained on show for some time. On a nearby verge Paul found *Orchis spitzelii* (Spitzel's Orchid) and *Gentiana angustifolium* (a Trumpet Gentian). We set up our picnic next to a ford in a small mountain stream, considerably swollen by the recent snow and rain. Bonelli's Warbler and Tree Pipit were heard, and *Orchis ustulata* (Burnt Tip Orchid) and the beginnings of *Platanthera bifolia* (Lesser Butterfly Orchid) as well as *Menyanthes arvensis* (Spigal), were found.

After lunch, as the rain again began to fall, we returned to the village of Menee, where we turned north and up into the Cirque d'Archiane, a splendid amphitheatre of towering rock faces and cliffs. Here we admired the splendid view and took photos. Retracing our steps, we made a stop while driving back up towards the Col de Rousset, to look at the captive breeding cage of the Griffon Vulture project. From here we continued our journey back to Rousset, where we stopped for coffee and on to La Chapelle en Vercors for dinner.

Day 7

Saturday 2nd June

Weather: Misty with low cloud and rain.

We began today by driving north through St.Martin en Vercors and St.Julien en Vercors, before turning west to the village of La Balme de Rencurel, where we turned south to Choranche, before ascending to the route de Presles, a magnificent limestone cliff face overlooking the valley of the River Bourne. Unfortunately, we were hampered by low cloud but a Peregrine Falcon flew close to one vehicle.

We stopped half way up to look at what we could see of the view. *Lathyrus sylvestris* (Narrow-leaved Everlasting Pea), *Anthericum liliago* (St. Bernard's Lily), *Ophrys apifera* (Bee Orchid) and *Limodorum abortivum* (Violet Birdsnest Orchid) were seen. Flying overhead there was one flock of seventeen and a second flock of four Alpine Swifts, and a Blackcap was heard. After spending a little time here, we moved on down to the valley and south to Pont en Royans. Paul and Alan decided that it may be drier if we made our way back down towards Plan de Baix.

We parked at a picnic site to the north of the village and took a walk up to the Croix du Vallen, a look-out point on a limestone promontory above the village. *Orchis tridentata* (Toothed Orchid), *Campanula persicifolia* (Peach-leaved Bellflower), *Phyteuma hemisphaerica* (Globe-headed Rampion), *Vicia onobrychoides* and *Orobancha gracilis* (Broomrape) were all seen. Philip's sharp eyes were also at work, when he spotted a Hoopoe and a solitary, grazing, female Red Deer. We took lunch under a series of Lime Trees in Plan de Baix, before retracing our steps back to Leoncel, where we turned up into more mist to make our way over the Col de la Bataille and down to the Col de la Machine, where we stopped for coffee and ice creams, before making our way back to La Chapelle in good time to get our packing started.

Day 8

Sunday 3rd June

Weather: Cloudy with some sun.

We left La Chapelle en Vercors at 06-45am, bidding Farwell to Mdme.Bellier, her family and staff. We retraced the route north on the A43 and A48 we had used when we had arrived, to the airport at Lyon. We arrived at Lyon airport at 10-00hrs in time to check in for our British Airways flight BA 361, departing at 11-55hrs.
