Pétillant Naturel

"Naturally sparkling wines have been made for centuries. Pétillant-naturel is a catch-all term for practically any sparkling wine made in the méthode ancestrale, the wine is bottled before primary fermentation is finished, without the addition of secondary yeasts or sugars."

Alsace

Alsacian wine is all about aromas. Floral and peachy smells fly out of the glass and many of the wines are unctuous enough to pair nicely with savory fowl, like roast quail. Alsace wines give the tingle of brilliant acidity but also offer a rich texture from moderate alcohol (some wines are 14 - 15% ABV). The producers in Alsace do not use oak aging to add spice and richness, instead they rely on a balance of ripeness and alcohol to fill out the flavor.

"After winemaking, yellow wine placed in oak barrels for 6 years and 3 months at least. It falls into the category of "oxidative" white wines but is not an oxidized wine. Oxidation is a defect in many wines, which is not the case for Vin Jaune."

Quarts-de-Chaume - Coteaux du Layon

"The Loire Valley has a long history of producing superb, luscious and riveting sweet Chenin Blanc wines from the appellations of Quarts de Chaume, Bonnezeaux, and Coteaux du Layon. Among the most extraordinary wines we have come across in the region are the Coteaux du Layon from Moulin Touchais. While the domaine produces a great number of wines from their 145 hectares of vineyards, the Coteaux du Layon accounts for less than 10% of their production and has earned them a reputation as a true jewel in Anjou."

Vouvray

Gaston understood clearly that quality must come first—and that quality started with great vineyards. His Haut-Lieu parcel, which lies on Vouvray's "Première Côte," or "first slope," is home to virtually all of the appellation's acknowledged grand cru vineyards.

As the estate prospered in the post-WWII era, Gaston secured two additional prime vineyards on the Première Côte that would ensure the domaine's stature: Le Mont (purchased in 1957) and Clos du Bourg (farmed since 1953, purchased in 1963). Collectively, these three vineyards account for Huet being the greatest of all Vouvray producers."

Côte Roannaise

"From the very upper reaches of the Loire River, come the delicious, yet mostly unknown, red wines of the Côte Roannaise. Once a major supplier of wine to Paris and the Royal Court, the wine-producing region has shrunk to a mere 250 acres producing 55,000 cases of wine a year. The Gamay grape flourishes on these steep, granite slopes. Many of the vineyards are terraced and the best sites have a southeastern exposure, with all harvesting done by hand. Beaujolais is just under 50 miles away, but a more different expression of the Gamay grape could not be found. Part of this difference is surely due to the fact that a different clone is used, the Gamay Romain."

"The village of Gigondas, a few miles to the northeast of Châteauneuf at the foot of the Dentelles de Montmirail, was the first Côtes-du-Rhône-Villages wine to win its own appellation, with nearby Vacqueyras the next to be so recognized. Like Châteauneuf-du-Pape, red wines from both of these villages are blends based on Grenache. Gigondas is typically more fruity and more supple than Châteauneuf du Pape, with wines from favored sites at the base of the hillside often showing a vibrant stony character. Vacqueyras is typically a more rustic variation on the Gigondas theme—chunkier and less aromatically complex but satisfyingly spicy, peppery, and ripe in the best years."

"Vega Sicilia is one of the most highly regarded—and unusual—wines on the planet. Of its two top labels, called Unico and Unico Especial, the first is released only after aging for at least a decade in barrels and bottles, compared with three years for the best wines from Bordeaux. The second, Especial, is a blend of grapes harvested in three different years, a rarity in the world of red wine, so the bottle doesn't have a vintage date on it. Fewer than 7,000 cases of Unico are produced each year on average, and only about 10% of those go to the U.S. "
