Delphine Collin-Vézina

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I am the Director of the [Centre for Research on Children and Families](#) at McGill University, a licensed clinical psychologist, a Full Professor at the McGill School of Social Work and an Associate Member in the Department of Pediatrics. I held the Tier II Canada Research Chair in Child Welfare from 2008-2018 and I am now holding the Nicolas Steinmetz and Gilles Julien Chair in Community Social Pediatrics. I am an invited Professor at the Institute of Anthropology: Interdisciplinary Studies on Human Dignity and Care (IADC), Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome.

My program of research seeks to better understand the impact of adverse and traumatic life events in the lives of children and youth, as well as their experiences with services geared towards them. I aim to promote and implement social responses which are better suited to meet the needs of this often marginalized population and their families. This mission is realized through research across two main axes:

- (1) Trauma-informed, children's rights-based approaches implemented in different settings, such as child protection agencies, social pediatric clinics, first-line social services, juvenile correctional services, and schools;
- (2) Best practices in the identification and responses to child sexual abuse across systems, and particularly within child protection services.

I have secured and administered, as Principal Investigator, 6.7 million CAN\$ in competitive grants, philanthropic gifts, and students' internships through the MITACS program. I have published 180 books, book chapters, peer-reviewed articles and professional articles. I have established the research group on Social Responses to Complex Trauma ([SR/CT](#)) at McGill University and have received a SSHRC Partnership grant to expand this work and establish the Canadian Consortium on Child and Youth Trauma ([CCCCYT](#)). I was recently awarded the CPA Traumatic Stress Section Award for Excellence in Psychology and a Medal of Honor from the Faculty of Arts and Science of Université de Montréal.

I am regularly invited as a keynote speaker, in national and international scientific and community venues. My influence is reflected by my participation in expert consultations organized by different ministries as well as through the citation of my work in policy and child welfare reports. My research work is often featured in printed and television/radio media. I have trained over 4,000 professionals from various disciplines in trauma-informed practices, across Canada, in France and other European countries.

COMMUNITIES OF PRACTICE

Elaborated by Harvard Business School scholars Wenger and colleagues, communities of practice are designed to stimulate innovation by ‘*creating groups of people who share a concern or a passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly*’. I have initiated and led ongoing half-day communities of practice in child protection agencies, social pediatric clinics and schools from various regions in Quebec. These meetings are held 4 times a year in each setting, totaling 40 half-day meetings every year. They now reach about 500 practitioners each year. An annual provincial community of practice is organized to bring these professionals together to share experiences and resources. Here a summary of the [2019](#) edition of the provincial community of practice.

On November 5, 2019, I was invited as a child maltreatment expert to present my work on child trauma before the *Commission spéciale sur les droits des enfants et la protection de la jeunesse*, which is an unprecedented provincial policy initiative that aims to review the Quebec child protection system. On this occasion, I reiterated the importance of making major organizational changes in youth protection services in order to provide adequate social responses to the complex traumas experienced by children. The recommendations I made were based on the work I have been doing as director of the McGill Centre for Research on Children and Families and as lead scientist of the Research Group on Social Responses to Complex Trauma (SR/CT).
